Life jacket loaner program. Borrow a life jacket for free, courtesy of the Sea Tow Foundation. Please return the life jacket when you're finished and enjoy a safe day out on the water.

It could save your life.

Did you know...?

All boats are required by law to have a U.S. Coast Guard-approved, properly fitting life jacket for each person on board.

A life jacket can help you survive in cold water.

A life jacket must fit snugly. Make sure there is no excess room above the openings and that the jacket does not ride up over the wearer's chin or face.

All states have regulations regarding life jacket wear by children. Adult-sized life jackets will not fit properly.

All Children 6 years of age and under must have a properly fitted life jacket on at all times.

Life jackets should be checked regularly for damage. If broken or ripped, they should be replaced.

Boats that are 16 feet and over in length must also have a throwable flotation device.

75% of fatal boating accident victims drowned, and of those 84% were not reported as wearing a life jacket.* Don't be a statistic. Borrow a life jacket today.
